



## Broom House Lambing Events 2017

### Further information and terms and conditions

**(Events running on 18/19<sup>th</sup>, 25/26<sup>th</sup> March, 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> April and each day between 8<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> April 2017)**

#### 'Lambing Shed Live'

This event includes a tractor trailer ride to the farm and back and a guided tour of the Broom House farm yard and lambing shed. The **trailer ride starts from the coach park located adjacent to the visitor entrance to the Wallington Hall National Trust property** and takes approximately 10 minutes to reach the farm.

To find Wallington Hall, follow the brown signs from the A696 and A68. If you have satellite navigation, the postcode is NE61 4AR.

Tours start at 12.30 pm and 2.00pm on **18/19<sup>th</sup>, 25/26<sup>th</sup> March, 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> April and each day between 8<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> April 2017**. A limited number of places are available on each tour. Booking in advance is recommended to avoid disappointment. Unsold seats will be available on a first come, first served basis on the day further information available at the Wallington Hall entrance kiosk. The lambing shed live tour takes 1½ hours.

- Lambing Shed Live is not suitable for pregnant women
- Please wear warm clothing and footwear suitable for a farmyard
- Toilets and hand washing facilities are available at the farm (all visitors must thoroughly wash their hands before leaving the farm)
- Visitors are asked not to eat, drink or smoke on during the tour
- Young children must be supervised by a responsible adult during the tour
- Wheelchair users are welcome and part of the farm yard is wheelchair accessible. Please contact Ian on 07469203088 before booking to discuss your requirements.
- No dogs are allowed in the farmyard at lambing time

#### Charges

Charges are £6 for adults and £5 for children (2-16 years). Children under 2 visit the farm free of charge, but are expected to sit on a parent's knee on the trailer if the tour is full. We advise pre booking and making payment using our web based booking system. Charges include VAT.

## **'Lambing Apprentice'**

A unique opportunity to gain hands-on experience as part of the lambing team at Broom House during the peak lambing season. Apprentices can sign up for an afternoon shift and get involved in routine tasks in the lambing shed, including;

- care of newborn lambs
- orphan lamb bottle feeding
- providing feed water and hay in the lambing pens & mucking out
- caring for ewes

Availability is limited to a maximum of two apprentices per shift, ensuring full participation and supervision.

Sessions run each afternoon on **18/19<sup>th</sup>, 25/26<sup>th</sup> March, 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> April and each day between 8<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> April 2017** from 2pm to 4 pm (2 hours).

### How to find us

**Lambing Apprentices should come directly to Broom House Farm 15 minutes before the shift starts.** To get to the farm from the car park at Wallington Hall, turn left on the road towards Cambo after 400 yards, you will come to a cross roads – take the left turn (signposted for Kirkwhelpington). Travel along this straight road for  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile and you will see the track to the farm on the right hand side. To find Wallington Hall National Trust property, follow the brown signs from the A696 and A68. If you have satellite navigation, our postcode NE61 4AT will bring you straight to the farm.

- Lambing Apprentice is not suitable for pregnant women
- Please wear warm clothing or overalls and footwear suitable for a farmyard
- Toilets and hand washing facilities are available at the farm (all visitors must wash their hands before leaving the farm)
- Visitors are asked not to eat, drink or smoke on during their time on the farm
- Children under 16 must be accompanied by a responsible adult
- Wheelchair users are welcome and part of the farm yard is wheelchair accessible. Please contact Ian on 07469203088 before booking to discuss your requirements.
- No dogs are allowed in the farmyard at lambing time

Charges are £30 per participant for Lambing Apprentice. We advise pre booking and making payment using our web based booking system. Charges include VAT.
