Lambing Shed Live!

Dates: Every day between Friday 30th March (Good Friday) & Sunday 15th April 2018

Departure times (Wallington Hall NT Property): 12.30 and 2.00pm each day (each tour lasts 90 minutes).

A unique opportunity for a guided tour of the lambing shed during the peak lambing season - You might even see a lamb born (65% of the visitors in 2017 did!):

- Fantastic learning experience and great fun for children and adults alike (unfortunately this event is not suitable for pregnant women)
- Tractor/trailer ride to the farm and back from Wallington Hall National Trust property
- Bottle feed the orphan lambs & visit the 'lamb hospital' and see how we look after newborn lambs in intensive care
- Suitable for all weather conditions (most of the tour is under cover)
- Toilets and hand wash facilities on-site at the farm

Cost: Adults and Children (2-16yrs) - £6, Children under 2 visit for free (if they travel on a parent's knee). **Pre booking advised. Unreserved seats will be offered on the day on a first come – first served basis at the trailer pick-up point.**

Lambing Apprentice

Dates: **Friday 30th March to Monday 9th April and Thursday 12th April to Sunday 15th April 2018 (2pm – 4pm each day).**

Join the Broom House lambing team for an afternoon shift, caring for the pregnant ewes and newborn lambs, helping with all of the routine tasks in the lambing shed.

Pre-booking is required. A maximum of two apprentices can book per shift.

Minimum age 10 years (children 10 -16 years must be accompanied by a responsible adult). Cost: £35 per apprentice
